POTENTIAL PROPERTY ACQUISITION

NEW ZEALAND GRADUATE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

Council received updates from the Vice-Chancellor and the Chief Operating Officer with respect to steps required to progress the establishment of the New Zealand Graduate School of Medicine.

Council resolved to approve the Vice-Chancellor entering into an agreement to acquire the curriculum for the NZGSM.

Council approved in principle the University proceeding with the development of stage 1 of the health precinct.

Council endorsed the Vice-Chancellor and Chief Operating Officer entering into the third and final stage of the Early Contractor Involvement procurement process for stage 1 of the health precinct.

UNIVERSITY OF WAIKATO INTERNATIONAL PLAN 2025-2029

Council resolved to approve the University of Waikato International Plan 2025-2029 which had been developed through consultation with staff, students and relevant stakeholders.

INVESTMENT PLAN MID-YEAR PROGRESS REPORT

Council received a mid-year update against the University's 2025-2029 Investment Plan forecast Statement of Service Performance.

EDUCATIONAL PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

Council received a report that provided a comparison of the University's published 2024 Education Performance Indicator results with that of other New Zealand universities.

Council received the draft minutes of the Academic Board meeting held on 25 July 2025.

REPORT OF THE HONOURS COMMITTEE

Council resolved to approve a recommendation from the Honours Committee with respect to the offer of a University of Waikato honorary award.

Council considered a proposal from the Pro Vice-Chancellor of the Division of Management to change the structure of the schools in that Division.
